The 'Musical Youth Foundation' (CHY#18624) was established by Dublin City Soul Festival as part of our desire to effect positive change on the local community.

Aside from independent fundraising initiatives the MYF will benefit, in part from the future financial success of the Dublin City Soul Festival with a percentage of ticket sales revenue going directly to the MYF in due course. Furthermore it is hoped that the MYF can encourage Irish concert promoters to follow suit and make an annual contribution to the foundation for the benefit of the local and wider community.

Long term plans for the Musical Youth Foundation include the establishment of satellite groups in major cities across Ireland. Furthermore the MYF aim to establish a Music Academy in Dublin City, where children under 18 can go to practise their instruments, establish bands and benefit from mentoring from industry experts including high profile artists in a safe and secure environment.
